

Experience Montenegro

Mountain, Sea and Lake

In only 30 km distance feel and experience the most beautiful landscapes of Montenegro. From Old Capital, the city – museum Cetinje go through National parks, parts of the UNESCO World Heritage list, capital of tourism, beaches, lakes, mountains and many more...

1.Day

Arrival at Cetinje, accommodation and dinner in Hotel Grand Cetinje.

2. Day – Cetinje, Old Capital of Montenegro

Breakfast in Hotel, walking tour through the town. Visiting the national museums treasures: State Museum (King Nikola`s Castle), Njegoš`s museum (Biljarda), The Museum of Ethnography (Former Serbian Embassy), The Court Archive, The Library . Lunch in one of National restaurants. Free time, dinner in Hotel and overnight.



3. Day – National Park Skadar Lake (20 km away)



Visiting the biggest lake on the Balkan peninsula with rare beauty, various species and plants, pleasant climate, natural wonders, rich heritage, all this at one place, Montenegrin National park, Skadar Lake. You`ll enjoy a boat cruise on the lake, clear water, lush lake vegetation, birds and fresh fish lunch in a local restaurant, prepared and

served in traditional way. Drive back to Hotel, dinner and overnight.

4. Day – Bay of Kotor



The bay, called Europe's southernmost fjord. It is one of the most important tourist attraction in Montenegro. The religious heritage of the land around the bay — its numerous [Orthodox](#) and [Catholic](#) Christian churches and monasteries — makes it one of the major pilgrimage sites of the region. Visiting Old Town in Kotor, part of the UNESCO World Heritage list. Panoramic ride by boat through the fjord, enjoying the sight of steep mountains and calm sea. Visit a

holy place on the unique artificial island “Gospa od Skpjela” with its 68 frescoes. After lunch served on board you can swim and relax in the sun. . Drive back to Hotel, dinner and overnight.

5. Day – National park Lovcen (10 km away)



Visiting Lovcen, The Mausoleum of Petar II Petrovic Njegos which was built in 1947. on Jezerski peak (1657 m high). It is 37 m long, 15.5 wide and 11 m high. The Mausoleum complex is finished with a threshing floor (Gumno), which has a view of the sea, Skadar lake and the mountainous interior of Montenegro. Lunch will be served in national restaurant on the Ivan's riverbeds on the 12th km from Cetinje to Lovcen, under the Mausoleum, in the heart of National park. After lunch break you can choose, walk through forest or try yourself in Adventures park. . Drive back to Hotel, dinner and overnight.

6. Day – Budva (30 km away)



Trip to one of the oldest cities in the coastal region of Montenegro, tourist Capital of Montenegro, Budva. Visiting monuments in Old Town, Church and Monastery from 7th century. Drive to Becici, swimming and relaxing at one of the most beautiful beaches on the coast. . Drive back to Hotel, dinner and overnight.

7. Day – Cetinje (Relics and Cults)

Visit The Monastery at Cetinje, which is first erected by Crnojevic family in 1482. From 1704. it has become the home Montenegrin spirituality, and many religious and treasures. Visit Vlaska Church, Court Church and The monument to Bishop Danilo Petrovic which is built on Orlov Krs. Three great Christian holy items are kept in Cetinje, the icon of the Our Lady og Philerme, the hand of Saint John the Baptist and fragment of the Holy Cross.

The relics arrived in Montenegro after centuries of travel, from Jerusalem, where, according to legend, the icon had been painted by the Apostle Luke.

It passed through Rhodes and Malta, where it belonged to the Chevaliers of Malta who received it from the Turkish Sultan as a sing of gratitude.

Lunch in one of national restaurants. Free time, dinner in a Hotel.



8 . Day

Departure from Montenegro.
